

# CLUB FUNDS AVAILABLE TO COMMUNITY GROUPS

**Last year registered clubs in NSW supported community and sporting groups to the tune of more than \$100 million.**

More than half of this support came from medium and large sized clubs who participate in the *Community Development and Support Expenditure (CDSE)* scheme.

The CDSE scheme is a shared arrangement between registered clubs (with gaming machine revenue over \$1 million per annum) and the NSW State Government. It is funded by a 1.5% gaming machine tax rebate provided by the State Government.

A Local Committee has been convened in each Council area to make funding recommendations to local CDSE clubs.

Applications for *Category 1* funding are now open to

community groups requiring funding for programs in 2008. Projects in the following categories qualify for Category 1 funding:

- Community welfare and social services
- Community development
- Community health services
- Employment assistance activities.

Applications for *Category 2* grants (including sporting, cultural and other activities) are administered directly by the clubs.
